Key Projects

SR 739 (Evans Avenue), Fort Myers, Florida - Public Information Officer for Community Awareness Program for the reconstruction and widening of Evans Avenue from Hanson Street to Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard. In addition to the roadway widening, this project includes installation of new water lines. Activities include close coordination with the Florida Department of Transportation, Lee County Utilities and the City of Fort Myers Utilities during construction for roadway closures, maintenance of traffic, media coordination, and water shut-off and boil water notifications. Community Awareness Program conducted for the Florida Department of Transportation, District One.

U.S. 41 from Old U.S. 41 in Collier County to Old U.S. 41 in Lee County, Florida – Public Information Officer for the State of Florida Department of Transportation’s six-laning project. Duties include addressing the public’s issues and concerns throughout the construction process. A public information workshop was held at the onset of the project to inform the public about the construction phasing. Notification newsletters were prepared for distribution to the affected property owners and tenants along the corridor.

Interstate 75 (I-75) Final Design, Collier and Lee counties, Florida - Public Information Officer for the final design of I-75 from SR 951 in Collier County to SR 80 in Lee County. The design efforts extend from the future I-75 Golden Gate Parkway interchange in Collier County to SR 80 interchange in Lee County. The public involvement program includes project newsletters and public information meetings. Other duties of the public involvement program include responding to public comments and questions about the project and a project website detailing information about the final designs and the PD&E study findings for the project segments.

First Street (SR 80) Utility Project, Fort Myers, Florida - Public Information Project Manager for this City of Fort Myers project which included the complete replacement of underground utilities. Work consisted of extensive coordination with City staff and officials, project team members, property owners and the general public. Newsletters and notification flyers announced project information about extensive route changes and traffic detours. Regular meetings were held with property owners and tenants to discuss project progress, roadway conditions and property owner concerns. Coordination of water shut-offs, boil water notices and rescission notices for affected properties and obtaining temporary and permanent easements from property owners.
